



## NOTES

1. The team leader needs to complete the form and receive the signature of the District Commander or the District Missions Coordinator. Include payment for the awards and pins. (*\*If this is a regional team then the form needs to be submitted to the regional office; a national team will need to be submitted to the national office.*) While the District Commander or the District Missions Coordinator is authorized to purchase the awards and pins, as a convenience to you, Mike King will authorize GPH to ship the restricted pins to the team coordinator once this completed form is received.
2. Projects issued an official name and/or number, prior to travel, from U.S. Missions or World Missions may qualify as a PathFinder Missions trip.
3. Gold PathFinder Missions must be pre-approved by the PathFinders Committee and have an official AGWM project number. Silver PathFinder Missions must have an official AGWM project number. Bronze PathFinder Missions must be pre-approved by U.S. Missions; these are identified by a name only, no project number is assigned.
4. FCF members receive the PathFinder Award and the corresponding colored “diamond” pin. Non-FCF Royal Rangers and non-Royal Rangers receive the corresponding colored “diamond” pin alone.
5. All overseas PathFinder teams must secure the mandated AGWM insurance. All U.S. teams must provide proof of insurance to the U.S. Home Missions office or purchase their insurance.
